

ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT RIOTOUS OR DISORDERLY CONDUCT IN CERTAIN PUBLIC PLACES

AN ORDINANCE to prohibit riotous or disorderly conduct in any street, highway, public building or other public place in Patrick County, Virginia, and to prescribe the punishment therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, that it shall be unlawful for any person to behave in a riotous or disorderly manner in any street, highway, public building or any other public place within the County of Patrick, State of Virginia.

Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500.00 or by confinement in jail not exceeding 12 months, or both, in the discretion of the Jury or of the Trial Justice, or of the Court trying the case without a Jury.

All fines collected by the Trial Justice Court of Patrick County, or by the Circuit Court of Patrick County on any case which may be appealed to that Court, shall be paid into the hands of the Treasurer of Patrick County, at such times as may be practicable as provided by the general laws of the State of Virginia.
