

The following ordinance proposed by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County at a regular meeting on April 11, 2011 and after public discussion this day, April 11, 2011, on motion by Lock Boyce, seconded by Crystal P. Harris and carried, is hereby adopted:

**AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
“RE-APPORTIONMENT OF ELECTION DISTRICTS”**

This Ordinance shall be known as the Re-Appportionment of Election Districts of Patrick County, Virginia.

The purpose of this article is to create and establish the election districts of Patrick County, Virginia. The election districts, with populations contained therein, are as follows:

<u>DISTRICT</u>	<u>POPULATION</u>
1. Blue Ridge	3,546
2. Dan River	3,828
3. Mayo River	3,786
4. Peters Creek	3,771
5. Smith River	3,559

The boundaries of the respective election districts are as follows:

BLUE RIDGE ELECTION DISTRICT

BEGINNING at a point on the Patrick County – Carroll County line at the intersection of Route 608 and Route 633; thence northeasterly with the Patrick County – Carroll County line to the Floyd County line; thence northeast with the Patrick County – Floyd County line to milepost 169 on the Blue Ridge Parkway and the intersection with the Smith River District; thence a straight line south – southeasterly to the center of U. S. Route 58 at Lover’s Leap Overlook as maintained by the Virginia Department of transportation; thence southeasterly down the ridge with the top of the main ridge to Route 8 at the highest point of elevation between Route 640 and Route 805; thence south with the center of Route 8 to the intersection of Route 8 and Route 58; thence with the center of Route 58 through Stuart with the center of Route 58 to Route 835; thence southerly with the center of Route 835 to Route 681; thence southeasterly with

the center of Route 681 to Route 727; thence southwesterly with the center of Route 727; thence southwest with the center of Route 727 to Route 631; thence south with the center of Route 631 to Route 652; thence northwest with the center of Route 652 to Route 660; thence west with the center of Route 660 to Route 8; thence north with the center of Route 8 to Route 103; thence a straight line northwest to the intersection of Route 644 and Route 631; thence northwesterly with the center of Route 631 to a point on Route 631 where the South Mayo River comes from a northerly direction and Route 631 turns sharply southwest; thence upstream with the center of the South Mayo River to a gap west of Rock Mountain; thence leaving the South Mayo River southwesterly to the highest point in Pinnacles of Dan, elevation 2,965 feet; thence southwesterly in a straight line to a high peak of elevation 2,682 feet, (this line crosses Hickory Cove Creek and the 2,682 foot peak is south of Roaring Creek); thence westerly crossing the Dan River and Route 648 in a straight line to a peak with an elevation of 2,725 feet just east of Route 614; thence due west in a straight line to the intersection of Route 608 and Route 633 and the Patrick County - Carroll Country line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

The names and boundaries of the voting precincts contained in the Blue Ridge Election District are as follows:

MEADOWS OF DAN VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of US Route 58 at the center of Lovers Leap Overlook as maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation on the line between Blue Ridge and Smith River Districts; thence southwesterly to the top of Rock Mountain; thence southwest to a point in the South Mayo River on the Blue Ridge and Dan River District line (lying in a gap west of Rock Mountain); thence westerly with the Blue Ridge District line and continuing with the Blue Ridge District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING PRECINCT

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of US Route 58 at the center of Lovers Leap Overlook as maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation on the line between Blue Ridge and Smith River Districts; thence a southwesterly direction to the top of Rock Mountain; thence a southwesterly direction to (lying a gap west of Rock Mountain) a point in the South Mayo River on the Blue Ridge and Dan River District lines; thence southeasterly with the Blue Ridge

District line and continuing with the Blue Ridge District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

DAN RIVER ELECTION DISTRICT

BEGINNING at a point on the Patrick County, Virginia – North Carolina State line at the intersection with the Peters Creek District and Route 663; thence west with the Patrick County, Virginia – North Carolina State line to the Patrick County and Carroll County line; thence northerly with the Patrick County – Carroll County line to near the Blue Ridge Parkway; thence southeasterly with the Patrick County – Carroll County line to the intersection of Route 633 and Route 608 on the Blue Ridge District line; thence easterly with the Blue Ridge District boundary with the Peters Creek District line; thence southerly with the Peters Creek District boundary with the Patrick County, Virginia – North Carolina State line and Route 663 to the point of **BEGINNING**.

The names and boundaries of the voting precincts contained in the Dan River Election District are as follows:

WILLIS GAP VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the Patrick County, Virginia and Surry County, North Carolina line at the Dan River District line in the center line of State Route 617; thence northwesterly with the center line of Route 617 to State Route 773; thence northerly with the center line of Route 773 to Route 631; thence northerly with the center line of Route 631 to Route 872; thence northwesterly with the center line of Route 872 to the end of state maintenance; thence northerly to the Patrick County – Carroll County line at Puckett's Cabin on the Blue Ridge Parkway on the Dan River District Boundary; thence westerly with the Dan River District Boundary and continuing with the Dan River District Boundary to the point of **BEGINNING**.

ARARAT VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center line of Route 648 on the Blue Ridge and Dan River District line; thence southerly with the center line of Route 648 to Route 773; thence westerly with the center line of State Route 773 to Route 614; thence southerly with the center line of State Route 614 to Route 103; thence southwesterly with the center line of State Route 103 to the Patrick County, Virginia and Surry County, North Carolina lines on the Dan River District line;

thence with the Patrick County, Virginia and Surry County, North Carolina line and with the Dan River District line westerly to the center line of State Route 617; thence northwesterly with the center line of State Route 617 to Route 773; thence northerly with the center line of State Route 773 to Route 631; thence northerly with the center line of State Route 631 to Route 872; thence northwesterly with the center line of State Route 872 to the end of state maintenance; thence northerly to the Patrick County – Carroll County line at Puckett's Cabin on the Blue Ridge Parkway on the Dan River District Boundary; thence easterly with the Dan River District Boundary to the point of **BEGINNING**.

CLAUDVILLE VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center line of State Route 648 on the division line of the Blue Ridge and Dan River Districts; thence southerly with the center line of Route 648 to Route 773; thence westerly with the center line of Route 773 to intersection of Route 781; thence northwesterly in center line of Route 773 to Route 614; thence southerly with the center line of Route 614 to Route 103; thence southwesterly with the center line of Route 103 to the Patrick County, Virginia and Surry County, North Carolina lines and on the Dan River District line; thence with the Patrick County, Virginia and Surry County, North Carolina line and with the Dan River District line an easterly direction and continuing with the Dan River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

MAYO RIVER ELECTION DISTRICT

BEGINNING at a point on the Patrick County – Henry County, Smith River District line in the center of Elf Trail; thence southerly with the Patrick County – Henry County line to the North Carolina State line; thence westerly with the Patrick County, Virginia and North Carolina State line to 3100 Moorefield Store Rd. (State Route 631); thence with the center line of State Route 631 northeast and continuing with the center line of State Route 631 which becomes State Route 700 northeast; thence north with the center line of State Route 700; thence northwest with the center line of State Route 700 to the median strip of U S 58; thence continuing west with the median strip of US 58 to State Route 626; thence northeast with the center of State Route 626 to Spoon Creek; thence northwest with the center of Spoon Creek to State Route 653; thence continuing with the center of Spoon Creek northwesterly to Route 772; thence a straight line to the intersection of Route 680 and Route 689; thence northwest with the center of Route 689 to Route 690; thence southwesterly with the center of Route 690 to

Route 686; thence northwest with the center of Route 686 to Route 687; thence west with the center of Route 687 to the Tudor Orchard – Bull Mountain Fire Tower Road on the Smith River District line; thence northeast with the Smith River District line to the center of Elf Trail and the Patrick County – Henry County line to the point of **BEGINNING**. The names and boundaries of the voting precincts contained the Mayo River Election District are as follows:

CRITZ/STELLA VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center of the intersection of State Route 626 and State Route 627 on the Patrick County and Henry County border on the Mayo River District boundary; thence a straight line southwesterly to the center line of the Route 693 bridge over Laurel Creek; thence a straight line southwesterly to the center line of the Route 693 bridge over Laurel Creek; thence a straight line southwesterly to the center of Route 694 bridge over Spoon Creek on the boundary lines of Mayo River and Peters Creek Districts; thence southerly with the Mayo River District line and continuing with the Mayo River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

LIBERTY VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center of the intersection of Route 626 and Route 627 on the Patrick County – Henry County line on the boundary of Mayo River district; thence a straight line southwesterly to the center of Route 693 bridge over Laurel Creek; thence a straight line southwesterly to the center line of Route 694 bridge over Spoon Creek on the Mayo River – Peters Creek District line thence northwesterly with the Mayo River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

PETERS CREEK ELECTION DISTRICT

BEGINNING at a point on the Patrick County, Virginia – North Carolina State line at 3100 Moorefield Store Rd., State Route 631; thence west with the Patrick County, Virginia – North Carolina State line to State Route 663; thence northeast

with the center of Route 663 to Route 103; thence northeast with the center of Route 103 to Route 742; thence northwest with the center of Route 742 to Route 645; thence northeast with the center of Route 645 to Route 644; thence south with the center of Route 644 to Route 643; thence northeast with the center of Route 643 to Route 631 on the Blue Ridge District line; thence southeast with the border of the Blue Ridge District to the Smith River District line at the intersection of Route 727 and Route 681 (the southernmost point of the Smith River District); thence northeast with the border of the Smith River District to the intersection of Route 687 and the Tudor Orchard – Bull Mountain Fire Tower Road; thence southeast with the border of the Mayo River District line to 3100 Moorefield Store Rd., State Route 631 to the point of **BEGINNING**.

The names and boundaries of the voting precincts contained the Peters Creek Election District are as follows:

RUSSELL CREEK VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center of the intersection of Route 8 and Route 660 on the Blue Ridge District and Peters Creek Districts line; thence southwesterly with the center line of State Route 660 to the Patrick County, Virginia and Stokes County, North Carolina line and the Dry Pond voting precinct; thence east with the Patrick County, Virginia and Stokes County, North Carolina and the Peters Creek District line and continuing with the Peters Creek District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

PATRICK SPRINGS VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center line of Route 654 bridge over the South Mayo River on the Mayo River and Peters Creek District Boundaries; thence westerly up the South Mayo River to the center of Route 680 bridge over the South Mayo River; thence southerly with the center line of Route 680 to Route 682; thence northwesterly with the center line of State Route 682 to Route 651; thence westerly with the center line of Route 651 to Route 631, on

the Peters Creek and Blue Ridge District lines; thence northerly with the Peters Creek District line and continuing with the Peters Creek District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

DRY POND VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center of the intersection of Route 8 and Route 660 on the Blue Ridge District and Peters Creek District lines; thence southwesterly with the center line of Route 660 to the Patrick County, Virginia and Stokes County, North Carolina line and the Peters Creek District Line; thence westerly with the Patrick County, Virginia – Stokes County, North Carolina and the Peters Creek District line and continuing with the Peters Creek District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

SMITH RIVER ELECTION DISTRICT

BEGINNING on the Patrick County – Floyd County line at the intersection with the Blue Ridge District line at milepost 169 on the Blue Ridge Parkway; thence northeasterly with the Patrick County – Floyd County line to the Franklin County line and continuing southeasterly with the Patrick County – Franklin County line to the Henry County line; thence with the Patrick County - Henry County line to the center of Elf Trail; thence northwesterly with the center of Elf Trail to Route 687; thence northwesterly in a straight line to a peak with an elevation of 1420 feet (which is the nearest part of the ridge of Hog Pen Mountain); thence in a straight line southwesterly to the peak of Hog Pen Mountain, elevation 1841 feet; thence a straight line southwesterly to the top of Chestnut Knob; thence southwesterly in a straight line crossing Route 680 to a ridge on Bull Mountain with an elevation of 1736 feet; thence with the main ridge of Bull Mountain to Rich Wood Knob; thence southerly with the center of the Tudor Orchard – Bull Mountain Fire Tower Road to Route 687; thence southwesterly with the center of Route 765 to Route 58; thence easterly with the center of Route 58 to Route 727; thence southwesterly with the center of Route 727 to Route 681 and the boundary line of the Blue Ridge District; thence with the boundary of the Blue Ridge District to milepost 169 on the Blue Ridge Parkway and the Patrick County – Floyd County line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

The names and boundaries of the voting precincts contained in the Smith River Election District are as follows:

ELAMSVILLE VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING in the center line of Route 680 on the Smith River and Mayo River District lines; thence northwesterly with the center line of Route 680 to Route 57 and the junction of Sycamore Creek; thence downstream with Sycamore Creek the center line of the bridge on Route 618; thence westerly with the center line of Route 618 to the center line of the bridge over Smith River, thence downstream with the Smith River northeasterly to the Patrick County – Franklin County line on the Smith River District line; thence southeasterly with the Smith River District line and continuing with the Smith River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

WOOLWINE VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of US Route 58 at the center of Lovers Leap Overlook as maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation on the line between the Blue Ridge and Smith River Districts; thence northeasterly to the end of State maintenance of Route 736; thence with the center line of Route 736 to Route 613; thence easterly with the center line of Route 613 to Route 8; thence southeasterly with the center line of Route 8 to Route 613; thence with the center line of Route 613 northeasterly to Route 618; thence northwesterly with the center line of Route 618 to the center line of the bridge over Smith River; thence downstream with the Smith River to the Patrick County and Franklin County line on the Smith River District line; thence northwesterly with the Smith River District line and continuing with the Smith River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

PATRICK COUNTY COMMUNITY CENTER VOTING PRECINCT

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of US Route 58 at the center of Lovers Leap Overlook as maintained of Route 58 at the center of Lovers Leap Overlook as maintained by the Virginia Department of Transportation on the

line between Blue Ridge and Smith River Districts; thence northeasterly to the end of State maintenance of Route 736; thence with the center line of Route 736 to Route 613; thence easterly with the center line of Route 613; to Route 8; thence southeasterly with the center line of Route 8 to Route 613; thence with the center line of Route 613 to the center line of the bridge over Sycamore Creek; thence upstream with Sycamore Creek, southerly to its intersection with Route 57 and Route 680; thence a southeasterly direction with the center line of State Route 680 to a point on the Smith River and Mayo River District lines to the bridge over pole bridge creek; thence southwesterly with the Smith River District line and continuing with the Smith River District line to the point of **BEGINNING**.

One supervisor shall be elected from each election district created by this Ordinance. Should any section of provision of this Ordinance be decided to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section and provision of this Ordinance.

This ordinance shall become effective on April 11, 2011.
