

**SUPERVISORS ORDER BOOK NO. 16  
(Adopted August 11, 1997)**

The following ordinance proposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County held at the Patrick County Administration Building, on the 14th day of July, 1997, having been duly advertised for adoption as provided by law, after a hearing thereon, on motion by James E. Walker, seconded by James D. East and carried, it is hereby adopted:

**AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 18.2-308D OF THE  
1950 CODE OF VIRGINIA, AS AMENDED ENTITLED  
"FINGERPRINT EXAMINATION OF CONCEALED WEAPON  
PERMIT APPLICANTS."**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, as follows:

(a) Pursuant to Section 18.2-308D of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, the County hereby requires that all persons applying for a concealed handgun permit shall submit to fingerprinting for the purpose of obtaining the applicant's state and/or national criminal history record and provide personal descriptive information to be forwarded with the fingerprints through the Central Criminal Records Exchange to the Federal Bureau of Investigation for the purpose of obtaining criminal history record information regarding the applicant, and obtaining fingerprint identification from federal records pursuant to criminal investigations by state and local law enforcement agencies.

This ordinance shall become effective on the first day of September, 1997.
