

The following ordinance proposed at the regular October meeting having been duly advertised as provided by law is hereby adopted:

ORDINANCE TO REQUIRE PERSONS WHO SHALL, FOR COMPENSATION, ENTER INTO ANY BOND OR BONDS FOR OTHERS TO OBTAIN A REVENUE LICENSE.

AN ORDINANCE to require every person who shall, for compensation, enter into any bond or bonds for others, whether as a principal or surety, to obtain revenue licenses and to prohibit professional bondsman from entering into any such bond or bonds in Patrick County until he has obtained such licenses and to prescribe the amount of such license and the penalty for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, that every person who shall, for compensation, enter into any bond or bonds for others, whether as a principal or surety, shall obtain a revenue license in the amount of \$15.00; and no such professional bondsman shall enter into any such bond or bonds in Patrick County until he shall have obtained such license.

No license shall be issued for any year unless and until the applicant shall have first obtained a certificate from the Judge of the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia, that he is a person of good moral character and entitled to be so licensed.

It shall be unlawful to fail to comply with this ordinance and any person who violates the terms hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished accordingly and in addition their licenses may be revoked for failure to comply with this ordinance.

All fines collected by the Trial Justice Court of Patrick County, or by the Circuit Court of Patrick County on any case which may be appealed to that Court, shall be paid into the hands of the Treasurer of Patrick County, at such times as may be practicable as provided by the general laws of the State of Virginia.
