

**ADOPTED AUGUST 14, 2002**

The following ordinance presented at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Patrick County Administration Building thereof, on Wednesday, July 10, 2002, having duly advertised for adoption as provided by law, after a hearing held on Wednesday, August 14, 2002, on motion by Charles B. Smith, seconded by Crystal P. Harris and carried, is hereby adopted:

**AN ORDINANCE PURSUANT TO SECTION 53.1-120 AND 15.2-1612.1 OF THE 1950 CODE OF VIRGINIA, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED: "Fees Assessed for each Criminal or Traffic Conviction in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations and Circuit Court and for each Individual Admitted to Jail Following Conviction in the Aforesaid Courts".**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, as follows:

(a) Pursuant to Section 15.2-1612.1 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, the Sheriff of Patrick County shall impose a processing fee of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for any individual admitted to jail following a conviction in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations or the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia.

(b) Such assessment in Section (a) shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court in which the action is tried and remitted to the County Treasurer to be held by such Treasurer subject to the disbursements by the Patrick County Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff to defray the cost of processing arrested persons. The fee shall be assessed for each jail admittance irrespective of the number of counts or Court cases causing admittance to jail.

(c) The County hereby assesses as a cost incident to criminal and traffic cases in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations and the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia, the sum of \$5.00 for each criminal or traffic conviction.

(d) Such assessment in Section (c) shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court in which the action is tried and remitted to the County Treasurer to be held by such Treasurer subject to the disbursements by the Patrick County Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff's Office for the funding of Courthouse security personnel.

(e) The assessments provided for herein shall be in addition to all other costs prescribed by law.

(f) This ordinance shall be effective beginning August 15, 2002.

ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 18, 2002

The following "ordinance of correction" presented by the County Attorney at an adjourned meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Patrick County Administration Building thereof, on Wednesday, September 18, 2002, on motion by Roger L. Martin, seconded by Crystal P. Harris and carried, is hereby adopted:

The Ordinance passed by unanimous vote at the August 14, 2002 meeting. However, the Ordinance incorrectly cited Section 15.2-1612.1 instead of Section 15.2-1613.1 for authority and incorrectly assigned the collection duty to the Sheriff instead of the Clerk of Court. Therefore, the said Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, as follows:

(a) Pursuant to Section 15.2-1613.1 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended, the Clerk shall impose a processing fee, as a part of Court costs, of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) for any individual admitted to jail following a conviction in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations or the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia.

(b) Such assessment in Section (a) shall be collected by the Clerk of the Court in which the action is tried and remitted to the County Treasurer to be held by such Treasurer subject to the disbursements by the Patrick County Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff to defray the cost of processing arrested persons. The fee shall be assessed for each jail admittance irrespective of the number of counts or Court cases causing admittance to jail.

(c) The County hereby assesses as a cost incident to criminal and traffic cases in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations and the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia, the sum of \$5.00 for each criminal or traffic conviction.
