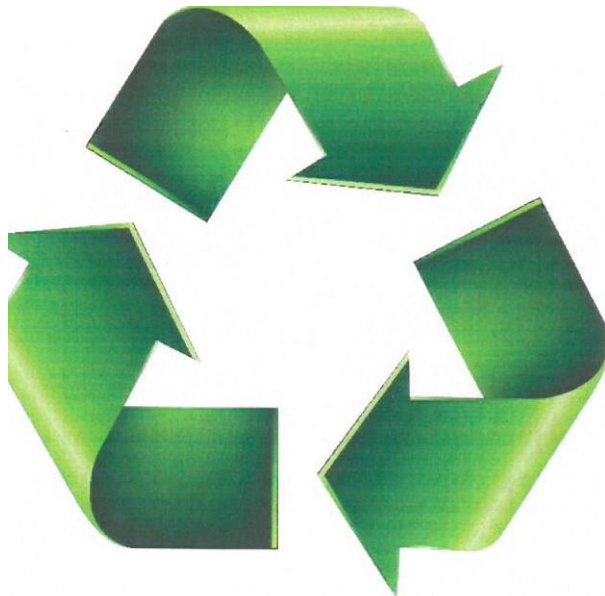
1st weekend of the month: Hardin Reynolds Elementary School

# Patrick County Mobile Recycling Program

## **Plastics:**

#1 and #2 plastics **only**. This notation is found on the bottom of most plastic inside the universal recycling emblem. 

Toys, clothes, hangers, bags, styrofoam, automotive oil containers, or any other plastic not labeled as a #1 or #2 recyclable product is unacceptable. These types of items will cause the entire bin to be dumped as general trash.

## **Newspaper/Magazines:**

All newspaper, paper and magazines, and paperback books not in a plastic sleeve. Hardbound books must have covers removed and discarded.

## **Metal Cans:**

Metal cans only. Aluminum cans should not be put in the mobile recycling units. Any small metal pieces that fit through the bin opening is allowed.

**NO CARDBOARD, GLASS, ALUMINUM CANS, PLASTIC SHOPPING BAGS, PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS, OR OTHER UNACCEPTABLE WASTE SHOULD BE DISCARDED IN THE MOBILE RECYCLING UNITS. CARDBOARD AND ALUMINUM CAN BE RECYCLED AT THE PATRICK COUNTY SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION.**

**PLEASE RECYCLE RESPONSIBLY SO THAT YOU DO NOT CANCEL OUT ANOTHER PERSON'S RESPONSIBLE RECYCLING. WE ARE NOT A SORTING FACILITY AND UNACCEPTABLE WASTE IN THE TRASH BINS CAUSE THEM TO BE DUMPED AS TRASH.**
