

Patrick County Planning Commission Meeting

Minutes of June 20, 2017

Present: Brenda Quesinberry, Chairman; Mike Helms, Vice-Chairman; Marbin Anderson, Ralph Cline and Brandon Simmons members of the Planning Commission, Roger Hayden, Board of Supervisor

Ralph Cline resigned from the Planning Commission on June 20, 2017 and excused himself before the meeting was called to order.

Call to Order:

Brenda Quesinberry, Chairman called the meeting to order seconded by Mike Helms and carried unanimously by all voting members present.

Approval of the Agenda and Minutes:

A motion was made by Roger Hayden to approve the agenda as presented and to approve the January 17, 2017 minutes as read and seconded by Mike Helms and carried unanimously by all voting members present.

New Business:

Brenda Quesinberry introduced Brandon Simmons to the Planning Commission. Mr. Simmons has been appointed to the Planning Commission to represent the Dan River District.

Brenda Quesinberry presented the Environmental Corporation of America proposal for a 175 ft Monopine telecommunications structure to go at Moonshine Drive at Primland in Meadows of Dan. The commission approved of the structure.

The Environmental Corporation of America stated in its report that it is seeking comments regarding the effect of the action described on historic properties in the community and that the commission may wish to become a consulting party. The commission decided that there was no need to become a consulting party as there are no concerns regarding historic properties in the area.

Old Business:

The Foley and Layman properties were reported to be off of the agenda.

The Planning Commission discussed the need for more cell towers in the County.

Roger Hayden discussed problems that he is facing obtaining funding and getting repairs for Virginia State Route 103.
