

Supervisors Order Book No. 6, p. 285
(Adopted June 30, 1939)

Be it Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership or corporation to sell wine and beer in the County of Patrick between the hours of 12 o'clock, P.M., of each Saturday, and 6 o'clock, A.M., of each following Monday.

Any person, firm, partnership or corporation, who violates any provision of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00, or imprisonment in jail for not less than one month, nor more than twelve months, either or both, in the discretion of the jury or court trying the same.

This ordinance shall not take effect until the first day of August, 1939.

The Clerk of the Board shall forthwith cause the foregoing ordinance to be published in the The Enterprise, a paper published in Patrick County, for two successive weeks, as provided by law, also forward a copy hereof to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, Richmond, Virginia.

Supervisors Order Book No. 8, p. 128
(Adopted January 9, 1967)

The following Ordinance proposed at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Courthouse of Patrick County on December 12, 1966 having been duly advertised for adoption as provided by law, after a hearing thereon, on motion of Harry M. Lawson, seconded by Willie J. Conner and carried is hereby adopted.

TO BE KNOWN AS AN ORDINANCE prohibiting the sale or consumption of beer and wine in Patrick County, Virginia, from 12:00 o'clock post meridian of each Saturday to 6:00 o'clock ante meridian of each Monday, and control the sale thereof and providing penalties for violation thereof pursuant to the terms of this Ordinance and the Code of Virginia, as amended, and other applicable divisions of law, including Section 4-97 of the Code of Virginia, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, partnership or corporation to sell wine and beer in the County of Patrick between the hours of 12:00 o'clock post meridian of each Saturday and 6:00 o'clock ante meridian of each Monday. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person, firm, partnership, or corporation holding a license to sell wine, beer and beverages or one or more of such shall not permit the consumption of either wine, beer or beverages upon the premises mentioned in such license.

Any person, firm, partnership or corporation, who violates any provision of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00, or imprisonment in jail for not less than one month nor more than twelve months, either or both, in the discretion of the jury or Court trying the same.

It is ordered that a copy of this Ordinance be certified to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, Richmond, Virginia.
