The following Ordinance proposed at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Courthouse thereof, on Tuesday, November 20, 1984, having been duly advertised for adoption as provided by law, on motion by Roscoe F. Epperson, seconded by J. Cornelius Stovall and carried, is hereby adopted:

Be it ordained by the Patrick County Board of Supervisors, at a regular meeting of the Board held at the Courthouse, Stuart, Virginia, on December 10, 1984, in accordance with Sections 15.1-29.5 and 24.1-165 of the Code of Virginia, the sense of the citizens of Patrick County, Virginia, having been taken by referendum placed on the election ballot during the November 6, 1984 general election, the provisions of Section 18.2-341 of the Code of Virginia (known as the Sunday Closing Law) shall hereby have no force and effect in the County of Patrick, Virginia.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption on December 10, 1984.
