

Supervisors Order Book No. 5
(Adopted December 10, 1929)

The Board of Supervisors desire to comply with the law in reference to the powers conferred on said Board by Code 1924 section 2743, in addition to the powers conferred by other general statutes the Board desires to:

- (1) Adopt quarantine regulations effecting both persons and animals, in the furtherance of the health of the county not inconsistent with general statutes.
- (2) To adopt the necessary regulations to prevent the spread of contagious diseases among persons or animals.
- (3) To prevent the pollution of water in Patrick County, where by it is ordered dangerous to the health or lives of persons residing in said county.
- (4) To prevent trespassing by persons, animals and fowls, and to prevent animals from trespassing and running at large upon the public highways, whether said highways be enclosed by fences or not.
- (5) To adopt such such measures as they may deem expedient to secure and promote the health, safety and general welfare of the inhabitants of this county not inconsistent with the general laws of this State.

To carry into effect these and their powers the Board of Supervisors will make ordinances and by-laws, and provide fines and other punishment for violation thereof, as provided by said sections.

It is ordered that this ordinance or by-law be published in the Stuart Enterprise for two successive weeks, as provided by law.
