ORDINANCE TO ABOLISH THE COUNTY FINANCE BOARD AND VEST ALL AUTHORITY, POWERS, AND DUTIES, OF THE FINANCE BOARD IN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PATRICK COUNTY, VIRGINIA

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County has authority under the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia, and more especially under the provision of Section 58-940 of the 1950 Code of Virginia, as amended by the Acts of the Legislature of 1954, to adopt an ordinance abolishing the County Finance Board and to vest the powers, authority, and duties of the Finance Board in the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, that the County Finance Board heretofore established under the provision of Section 58-940, be the same hereby is abolished and be it further ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County that all authority, powers, and duties of the County Finance Board of Patrick County shall vest in the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County Virginia.
