

The following ordinance presented at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors held at the Courthouse thereof, on Monday, April 11, 1983, having been duly advertised for adoption as provided by law, after a hearing held this day by the Board at 1:00 p.m., on motion by Edward V. Pilson, seconded by Charles C. Coalson and carried, is hereby adopted:

It is ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Patrick Virginia, that any person who is sixteen years of age or older, after first obtaining his or her parent's or guardian's approval, in writing, is authorized to work or to participate fully in all activities of a Volunteer Fire Company, provided such person has attained Certification under National Fire Protection Association 1001, Level One, Fire Fighters Standards as administered by the Virginia Department of Fire Programs.

The Certification record and parental or guardian consent shall be kept on file in the office of the Volunteer Fire Company for each participant who is enrolled in the Fire Company Pursuant to this Ordinance.

This Ordinance is effective May 9, 1983.
