

The following amended ordinance proposed by the Board of Supervisors of Patrick County at a regular meeting on Monday, December 14, 2020, and after public discussion thereof this day, on motion by Clyde DeLoach, seconded by Clayton Kendrick Jr., and carried, is hereby adopted:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PATRICK COUNTY, VIRGINIA ON JUNE 25, 2007, ENTITLED:

“FEES ASSESSED FOR EACH CRIMINAL OR TRAFFIC CONVICTION IN GENERAL DISTRICT, JUVENILE AN DOMESTIC RELATIONS AND CIRCUIT COURT AND FOR EACH INDIVIDUAL ADMITTED TO JAIL FOLLOWING CONVICTION IN THE AFORESAID COURTS”.

Be it ordained by the board of supervisors of Patrick County, Virginia, as follows:

Pursuant to Code of Virginia §53.1-120(D), paragraph “(c)” of the aforesaid ordinance is amended to read as follows, effective December 14, 2020.

(c) The County hereby assesses as a cost incident to criminal and traffic cases in General District, Juvenile and Domestic Relations and the Circuit Court of Patrick County, Virginia, the sum of \$20.00 for each criminal or traffic conviction. The assessment shall be collected by the clerk of the court in which the case is heard, appropriated by the Board of Supervisors to the Sheriff’s office. The assessment shall be used solely for the funding of courthouse security personnel, and, if requested by the Sheriff, equipment and other personal property used in connection with courthouse security.
